WHERE IS THE APARTMENT

- The apartment is located at the top of the outside stairs on the left
- You will find 3 key boxes to the left of the door
- You will find the key in the middle box
- The code is 1587

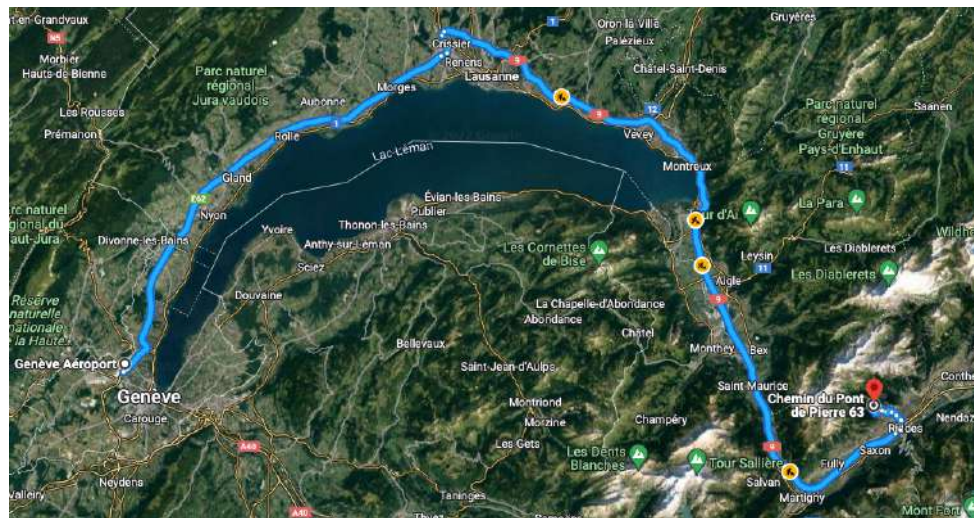
OPTIONS FOR ARRIVAL

WHERE IS THE SKI ROOM

- The ski room is in the basement
- To access it, you have to go to this side of the building
- Take these wooden stairs
- Then take the path that leads to this door



- Open the door with the apartment key
IMPORTANT: Lock the door after you leave
- The cellar to store your skis is at the end of the corridor on the left
- There is a key box against the door
- You will find the key in this box. The code is: 2496
IMPORTANT: Please put the key back in the box and do not keep it with you

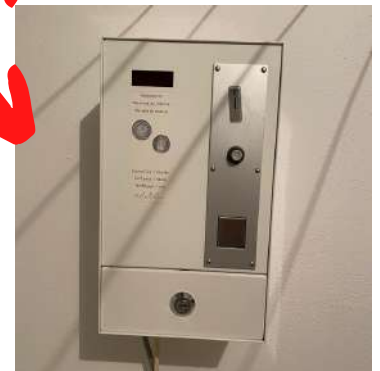


WHERE IS THE WASHING MACHINE AND THE TUMBLE DRYER

- The washing machine and dryer are in the basement
- To access it, you have to go to this side of the building
- Take these wooden stairs
- Then take the path that leads to this door



- Open the door with the apartment key
IMPORTANT: Lock the door after you leave
- The washing machine and tumble dryer are directly behind the door on the left
- Use these devices to pay (note that they do not give change)
- You have to turn on the switches



Please clean the washing machine and tumble dryer after use (clean the filter, close the water tap, remove washing powder, etc.)

ABOUT THE REGION

SUMMER & WINTER

Ovronnaz, a small resort and spa, is located in the French-speaking part of the Valais on a sunny plateau facing south.

Its thermal pools (two open-air), with temperatures ranging from 32 to 35 degrees, are renowned. In summer as in winter, visitors will always appreciate the panoramic view of the Rhone Valley.

Ski & bath, this combination is the ultimate in Ovronnaz. There is nothing more pleasant than to relax in the invigorating warmth of the thermal baths after an intense day in the snow. Two chairlifts and six ski lifts serve the Ovronnaz ski area at an altitude of between 1400 and 2500 m and allow everyone to enjoy winter sports.



THINGS TO DO

The waters of the Ovronnaz thermal baths, with their warmth and precious mineral elements, provide relaxation and well-being.

Inside, a thermal pool awaits you, as well as the 36°C Jacuzzi, the paddling pool and the three rest rooms.

Outside, you can soak up the sunshine in the two thermal pools with their jets, benches and massage beds, their swan necks and the three whirlpools. In summer, there is a terrace with sun loungers, a refreshment bar and a children's playground.

MINI ZOO OF JORASSE



The farm animals get some fresh air in Jorasse, at an altitude of 2000 m.

Geese, chickens, rabbits, goats and sheep amaze the little ones.

Alpacas and ponies await you: come and visit them!

Ponies are available for free rides on their backs in good weather.

A chairlift, all-terrain scooters, a sporty descent, 500 m of vertical drop, through alpine pastures and forest! The winning combination for a great experience with friends or family.
